Museum Shows \*Antoine de Saint-Exupery's Life and 'Little Prince' Magic

The Little Prince Museum opened 22 years ago. It was hoped that many people would learn about the book and the life of Antoine de Saint-Exupery (1900-1944).

He was the oldest son of a family in France, and loved airplanes and pictures. For him, ( ① ) and painting were important. After \*World War I, he became a pilot. It was his dream. After that, he wrote his first novel in 1929. It made him famous as a novelist. When \*World War II started, he went to the United States. He wrote "The Little Prince" as a Christmas gift for children in 1943.

The museum shows photographs taken in some parts of the world he went to. The museum also has a picture of an airplane Saint-Exupery flew in the \*entrance. You can also see the same picture on the \*advertisement. The museum shows the books of "The Little Prince" written in different languages.

The Little Prince books are read around the world and loved by a lot of people. Visitors will want to get the book when they leave the museum. Bringing the advertisement below will cut off ¥100 for each person. One advertisement can be used for four people. Let's go to the museum this summer.
